FUN PHONICS WITH FANTASTIC MR FOX

Here are some ideas for class or group activities when you have read the story of *Fantastic Mr Fox* aloud to the whole class.

- **Look at alliteration?**

There are lots of examples in the story:

Fantastic Fox

Boggis, Bunce and Bean

- **Play a word game with animals:**

Fantastic Fox, Clever Cat, Lovely Lion, Greedy Goat, etc.

Or collect as many names beginning with B as you can to add to the names Boggis, Bunce and Bean.

- **Look at the rhyme in the book about Boggis, Bunce and Bean.**

In a shared-writing session with the class, make up another rhyme in a similar style.

- **Act it out.**

Choose a short bit of the story to re-enact. Almost all children love to act out a story – especially if you provide some old hats for dressing up.
